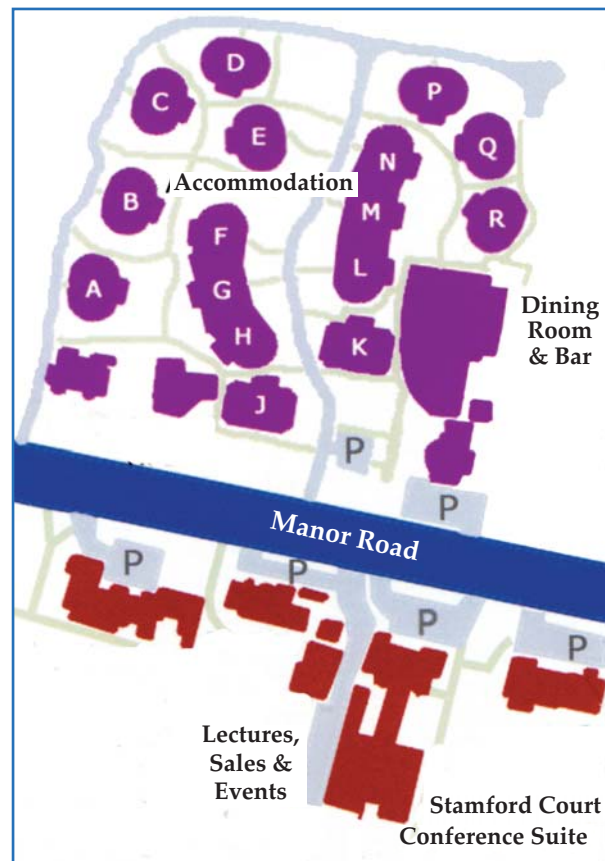

The Stamford Court Conference Suite is a new purpose-built state of the art facility adjacent to high quality single room accommodation.
